Title: Guidelines for Workload and Weight Criteria for Academic Staff for the 2025 Performance Evaluation (B.E. 2568)

According to the Mahidol University Regulations on Principles and Guidelines for Working Performance Evaluation for Staff 2022 (B.E.2565), dated 3 May 2022, the regulations have been revised. These regulations outline goals, indicators, weights, assessment criteria, or evidence required to clearly and appropriately represent the work achievement. A meeting on the AIHD Performance Agreement was held on 24 April 2024 from 1.00 – 4.00 hrs. at Boonsiri Hall to clarify the Performance Agreement and to consider the workload weights for academic staff for the Working Performance Evaluation in 2025 (B.E.2568), and the AIHD committee meeting passed a resolution no.5/2567 dated 24 May 2024. In this regard, the following revised workload and weight criteria for academic staff are to be considered for work performance evaluation;

- 1. The ASEAN Institute for Health Development letter no.78.1119, titled "Guidelines of weight criteria for academic staff", dated 22 July 2022 is hereby canceled.
- 2. The workload and weight criteria for academic staff (total workload 100%) are as follows;

## Lecturer

	Workload	Weight
1	Supporting strategic plan and/or action plan of university and institute	15 – 40 %
2	Main job responsibilities	35 -70 %
	(teaching work, research work, and academic services)	
3	Work assignments	10 – 20 %
4	Social activities for institute / university	5 %

## Researcher

	Workload	Weight
1	Supporting strategic plan and/or action plan of university and institute	15 – 40 %
2	Main job responsibilities	50 – 70 %
	(research work)	
3	Work assignments	10 – 20 %
4	Social activities for institute / university	5 %
